This is rural music as played in homes, at dances and for earlier entertainments such as minstrel shows and country radio.

Along with a repertoire including dance tunes, ballads, cowboy songs, humorous and sentimental numbers, blues and rags, he spices their shows with stories, history and folklore. Bob sings (yodels, too) and plays guitar, harmonica, banjo and autoharp.

He has performed for Prairie Home Companion, River City Folk, Chicago Museum of Science & Industry, Living History Farms (Des Moines), Merlefest, Toronto Folk Festival, and numerous others.
